iPhone 17 Pro Price in Vietnam 2025 — What You Need to Know

Official launch and base pricing in Vietnam

The iPhone 17 series — including iPhone 17, iPhone 17 Air, iPhone 17 Pro, and iPhone 17 Pro Max — officially launched for the Vietnamese market in September 2025. The pre-order started on September 12, and nationwide availability began around September 19.

According to official listing in Vietnam, the base prices for iPhone 17 Pro are: 256 GB — 34,999,000 VND, 512 GB — 41,499,000 VND, 1 TB — 47,999,000 VND.

These prices reflect the official retail price as set by the Vietnamese arm of and likely include VAT and standard import/distribution margins.

Real-world retail pricing—what buyers actually pay

In practice, many Vietnamese retailers offer slightly different prices, depending on promotions, stock availability, and whether the device is new or comes via parallel import. For example:

- One retailer lists the 256 GB iPhone 17 Pro at 34,290,000 VND.
- Another retailer shows a more aggressive price: 256 GB at 32,899,000 VND.
- Some vendors have the 256 GB version at 35,990,000 VND, 512 GB at 42,490,000 VND, and 1 TB at 49,990,000 VND.

Such price variations are common in the Vietnamese smartphone market. Factors influencing them include promotional discounts, stock clearance, store margin adjustments, or special trade-in offers. For many buyers, these real-world prices end up being slightly below the list price — especially if they catch a sale or promotional discount.

Why prices vary: what affects iPhone 17 Pro cost in Vietnam?

Several factors contribute to variations between official MSRP and retail prices in Vietnam:

- Import tariffs, taxes, and VAT When Apple imports devices for official distribution in Vietnam, cost includes customs duties, shipping, distribution, and VAT, which all contribute to the final retail price. This explains why iPhone 17 Pro in Vietnam doesn't carry the same USD-based price as in the U.S.
- Exchange rate fluctuations Since international prices are in USD, any fluctuations in currency rate against VNĐ will affect import costs and thus retail price. This can cause noticeable differences over time in what

Vietnamese buyers pay.

- **Retail margin, promotions, and discount strategies** Some authorized retailers offer discounts, trade-in deals, or temporary promotions that reduce the price below the official recommendation. As seen, some shops offer hundreds of thousands to over a million VND below MSRP.
- Stock availability & demand pressure When demand is high (new launch period) or certain color/storage variants sell out quickly, retailers may adjust prices upward or downward depending on supply. Conversely, to clear slow-moving stock, they may discount.

Which storage variant makes sense: 256 GB, 512 GB or 1 TB?

The iPhone 17 Pro offers three storage options: 256 GB, 512 GB, and 1 TB. Choosing the right one depends on how you use the device.

- **256 GB** This is the base model and suits average users: social media, photography, apps, some video, etc. It offers the best price-to-storage ratio for most people. Given current retail discounts, it's often available for around 32.9–34.3 million VND.
- **512 GB** If you regularly shoot high-definition video, store a lot of photos, or keep many large apps/games, the mid-tier storage makes sense. Price lies typically 6-7 million VND above the base.
- 1TB—For heavy users, content creators, or those who prefer to keep everything locally, this top option provides maximum flexibility. However, the price premium is significant compared to 256 GB.

For most average users, 256 GB remains the sweet spot. For professionals working with video/photo editing, large media libraries or heavy multitasking, 512 GB or 1 TB may be justified.

Should you buy now—or wait for price drops?

Since iPhone 17 Pro is newly released in Vietnam as of September 2025, demand remains high and supply uncertain. Historically, prices for iPhone "Pro" models tend to stabilize or drop slightly a few months after release, especially when retailers receive more stock or launch promotions.

If you need a phone urgently, buying now makes sense — you get official warranty coverage and the latest hardware. If you can wait a little, it might be possible to find the device at a more favorable price, especially 256 GB versions. Discounted deals or bundle offers (trade-in, accessories, or pay-in-installments) may also appear.

Conclusion — what buyers in Vietnam should know

The iPhone 17 Pro brings Apple's latest hardware and features to Vietnam in 2025, and for many users it will be the flagship of choice. Official starting price is 34,999,000 VND for the 256 GB version, but actual retail prices often vary between ~32.9 to ~36 million VND depending on the store and discount. Higher storage options (512 GB, 1 TB) come with a noticeable premium.

For buyers: think about how you'll use the phone. If you mostly browse, take photos, apps — 256 GB is usually enough. If you create content, shoot lots of video, or store large files — consider 512 GB or 1 TB. And if you're not in a hurry — watch for sales or promotions that might lower the cost a bit.

Overall, Vietnam remains a competitive market for the iPhone 17 Pro: local pricing stays reasonably close to global MSRP (after adjusting for taxes and conversion), and the presence of many retailers — official and authorized — gives buyers flexibility. With careful shopping, you can get a brand-new iPhone 17 Pro at a fair price and enjoy all its capabilities under Apple's official warranty.
