Release date and availability

The iPhone 17 Pro was officially announced by on September 9, 2025. Pre-orders for the device began on Friday, September 12, and it became widely available starting Friday, September 19, 2025.

In Europe, including Germany, the local Apple press release confirms the same timeline for pre-orders and retail availability.

Main features and improvements

iPhone 17 Pro represents a substantial leap forward compared with previous iPhone generations. Apple redesigned key aspects — from the chip and thermal system to cameras, display, battery life and material durability.

Performance, chip and internals

Under the hood, iPhone 17 Pro runs on Apple's new — the most powerful and efficient chip ever built for iPhone. Thanks to a new vapor-chamber thermal system integrated into a strong, lightweight aluminum unibody chassis, the device can sustain high performance for longer. This makes it ideal not only for demanding tasks like mobile gaming, video editing, or running advanced apps, but also ensures better heat dissipation and stability over time.

In addition to raw performance gains, the new chip enables advanced camera and AI-driven functionalities, giving the iPhone 17 Pro an edge in computational photography, video, and smart features.

Display, design and durability

The 17 Pro comes with a 6.3-inch Super Retina XDR OLED display (with a pixel density of 460 ppi), featuring ProMotion support up to 120 Hz, Always-On display mode, HDR, True Tone, Haptic Touch, wide color gamut (P3), and anti-reflection coatings. Peak brightness reaches up to 3000 nits outdoors — making it among the brightest displays on an iPhone.

Design-wise, Apple switched to an aerospace-grade aluminum unibody that houses the vapor chamber for heat dissipation and a larger battery. On the outside, the phone is protected by the new — not only on the front but, for the first time ever, also on the back. This upgrade makes the rear much more resistant to scratches and significantly reduces the risk of cracks.

Camera system and photography / video capabilities

One of the biggest upgrades with iPhone 17 Pro is its camera system. The phone features a triple 48 MP "Fusion" rear camera array: a main lens, an ultra-wide, and a completely new telephoto lens. The telephoto uses a next-generation tetraprism design and has a sensor about 56 % larger than previous models — translating into sharper photos, better performance in bright light, and improved detail in darker scenes. It supports a 4× optical zoom at 100 mm for classic portrait-style shots and an impressive 8× optical-quality zoom at 200 mm for distant subjects — the longest optical-quality zoom ever offered on an iPhone. Digital zoom extends up to 40×.

For selfies and video calls, 17 Pro introduces an 18 MP "Center Stage" front camera that uses machine learning to produce better, more natural images and to enhance framing for video calls and content creation.

On the video side, the new "Pro-level" features include support for , Apple Log 2, and genlock — tools that appeal directly to creators, filmmakers, and anyone serious about mobile video production. This makes iPhone 17 Pro not just a consumer phone, but a credible tool for professional-level media creation.

Battery life, charging and connectivity

Thanks to the efficient A19 Pro chip and optimized internal architecture, iPhone 17 Pro delivers one of the best battery performances in iPhone history. The larger internal space (enabled by the unibody design) accommodates a bigger battery, while thermal management ensures sustained performance without overheating.

Moreover, Apple claims you can reach 50 % battery in just 20 minutes when using a high-wattage USB-C charger such as the new 40 W Dynamic Power Adapter (with up to 60 W max).

On the connectivity front, iPhone 17 Pro supports the latest wireless and network standards — ensuring compatibility and future-proofing for years to come.

Storage options and colors

iPhone 17 Pro is offered with three storage configurations: 256 GB, 512 GB and 1 TB.

As for aesthetics, Apple offers three finishes: deep blue, cosmic orange, and silver.

Price

At launch, the base configuration of iPhone 17 Pro starts at €1,299 (including VAT) in Germany and other European markets. Higher storage options naturally come at a premium.

For buyers, that price reflects not just the hardware improvements, but also the shift in base storage (256 GB instead of lower tiers) and the advanced materials and components — which likely contributed to the increase compared with earlier Pro models.

Who is iPhone 17 Pro for?

Given its powerful chip, pro-level camera system, generous base storage, and premium build, iPhone 17 Pro is ideal for users who:

- Use their phone for heavy tasks — video editing, gaming, content creation, etc.
- Prioritize top-tier camera performance and flexibility (telephoto zoom, portrait work, night shots, video creation).
- Want longevity — both in terms of performance, software support, and build quality.
- Value a premium device and are willing to pay for higher-end features and quality.

On the other hand, if you only use your phone for basic tasks like messaging, browsing, and casual photography, the standard (non-Pro) models in the iPhone 17 lineup may offer much of the value for a lower price.
