Official Launch Schedule for iPhone 17

The iPhone 17 lineup — including the base iPhone 17, along with higher-end models like Pro and Pro Max — was officially announced on September 9, 2025.

Pre-orders for iPhone 17 opened on Friday, September 12.

Retail availability — when customers start receiving their devices and stores begin sales — began on Friday, September 19, 2025.

When Review Embargo Lifts—First Reviews Are Out

Because of the way handles press access to new iPhones, professional reviews are typically embargoed until a day or two before release. For iPhone 17, that meant the embargo most likely lifted on Tuesday, September 16, or Wednesday, September 17 — that's when the first official reviews were allowed to be published.

Indeed, respected review sites began publishing their hands-on reports around that time, giving readers a peek at performance, camera quality, battery life and other real-world details ahead of launch.

What Early Reviews Say—Highlights So Far
