The 233 g weight makes it comfortable when held, but over extended use (for example, watching long videos or reading) the heft can be felt more than on lighter phones.

That means existing accessories like some cases or holders designed for previous Pro Max models may not always fit perfectly — especially when thickness or camera-bump clearance matters.

Before you decide on the iPhone 17 Pro Max, here's a quick checklist of size-related pros and cons to consider:
