How Much Is iPhone 17 Pro Max in Australia — 2025 Price Guide

Official Australian Retail Price (RRP)

The official starting price for iPhone 17 Pro Max in Australia (at launch) is **A\$ 2,199** for the base storage model.

Depending on the storage capacity the price increases as follows (2025 lineup):

- 256 GB A\$ 2,199
- 512 GB A\$ 2,599
- 1TB A\$ 2,999
- 2 TB (new for this generation) A\$ 3,799

These prices reflect official recommended retail price (RRP) including GST, representing what you'd expect to pay buying a brand-new iPhone 17 Pro Max from an authorized retailer or online store in Australia.

What You'll See in Stores—Real-World Market Prices

In practice, retail prices for iPhone 17 Pro Max in Australian shops sometimes vary slightly from RRP. For example:

- A 256 GB model was listed at A\$ 2,099 on sale at one Australian retailer slightly below the official starting price.
- Standard retail listings at a major electronics retailer price the 256 GB variant around A\$ 2,197.

Thus, while RRP gives you the baseline, it's possible to find discounts — especially on the entry-level storage model. Still, the premium variants (512 GB, 1 TB, 2 TB) tend to remain close to their official price tag.

Why the Price Range — What Affects Cost?

There are a few factors that influence why the actual price you pay might vary from the official RRP:

- **Storage variant:** As with earlier iPhone generations, higher storage means a premium and that's quite significant for 512 GB, 1 TB, and 2 TB options.
- **Retailer promotions or sales:** Some retailers discount slightly (especially on base 256 GB), particularly during sales events or to clear stock.
- **Supply and demand / stock levels:** Immediately after launch, demand may drive prices up or make certain variants hard to get. Over time retailers may lower price on leftover units.

• Warranty, bundle & extras: Deals with trade-in options, carrier plans, or bundled accessories can affect effective cost — sometimes making the phone feel cheaper overall if you trade-in an older iPhone.

Is It Worth Buying New Now—Or Wait for Deals?

Considering the numbers, buying a brand-new iPhone 17 Pro Max 256 GB at around A\$ 2,099–2,199 is reasonable if you want the latest flagship and don't care about some of the pricier storage options. If you want larger storage (512 GB or higher), expect to pay significantly more — often A\$ 2,599 and up, depending on retailer.

If you are not in a rush, you might watch for occasional discounts. As seen in some listings, small savings (≈ A\$ 100) are possible on entry storage models. Larger storage variants rarely drop far below RRP though.

Also consider trade-in offers: official offers from the maker or retailers may give you credit toward the purchase when trading in a qualifying older iPhone; this can substantially offset the purchase cost.
