The smooth plastic — while good for pocket sliding and minimalist look — means grip can be lacking, and some users even describe the phone as "like a bar of soap".

Additionally, because the bottom is open (to allow easy swiping), the phone's lower edge is more exposed. That openness is a trade-off: convenient for gesture control, but slightly riskier if you drop the phone on a flat surface.

Good and Not-So-Good: Pros and Cons
